



## JEAN MONNET CHAIR in PRIVATE EUROPEAN LAW

## SHORT TERM RESEARCH STAY FOR LERU MEMBERS PhD CANDIDATES

The Jean Monnet Chair for Private European Law is held by Prof. Esther Arroyo at the University of Barcelona. The main aim of the Chair is to promote and reinforce the importance of European Private Law in research and teaching, in particular to develop skills of lasting value with the aim of exploring the attitude of the European legislator in the use of legal rules to regulate certain aspects of civil, social and economic life; learn to evaluate issues related to the evolution of European Private Law; improve the understanding of the *acquis communautaire* and its implementation in the Member States; and to demonstrate how Private Law can contribute to achieving a single European market.

This call is addressed to PhD candidates from any of the LERU member universities who have a topic related to European Private Law and would like to do a short term research stay (maximum of 10 days) at the Law Faculty of the University of Barcelona.

PhD researchers will be offered the opportunity to engage with academics that specialize in European Private Law. They will have free access to the law library and research facilities.

Candidates will be expected to make a presentation on their PhD topic, and their working paper may be published in open access via the repository of the UB, the Transjus Research Institute (UB) or the Jean Monnet's website (http://www.ub.edu/dret/Catedra Jean Monnet DPE/en/activitats en.html.

<u>Duration of the visit</u>: up to 10 days, from the 1<sup>st</sup> of March to the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2020.

Accommodation will be offered at the Sant Raimon de Penyafort Residence for a maximum period of 10 days at the EU Private Law Jean Monnet Chair expenses.

Application deadline: Candidates must apply before the 12<sup>th</sup> of February.
